# The Royle Scholarship Year 10 or Year 11 2025

The Royle Scholarship has been created in perpetuity to celebrate the Royle family's association with Abbot-sleigh over several generations. This scholarship is for a day girl or boarder with specific Old Girl affiliations.

## **Conditions**

- 1. The Royle Scholarship is an academic and/or general merit scholarship available to new applicants or current students entering day or boarding in Year 10 or Year 11. Needs-based criteria may also apply.
- 2. Academic, general merit and needs criteria are all relevant considerations, but no one of these criteria is essential or decisive.
- 3. Applicants must be the daughter or granddaughter or even great granddaughter of an Abbotsleigh Old Girl who attended Abbotsleigh as a student for at least one full school year.
- 4. The Scholarship is awarded on the basis of school reports, a student statement on participation in other activities endorsed by a school staff member, and an interview for selected candidates. Consideration is given to academic attainment, general interest and ability and participation in other activities, for example, school citizenship displayed in service and community activities, music, drama and sport.
- 5. Candidates wishing to rely on need as one of the criteria should provide financial information which will be confidential to a committee comprising the Treasurer of the School Council and the Headmistress.
- 6. The Scholarship will provide up to 50% remission in school tuition fees for the remainder of schooling provided work, conduct and general activities are thoroughly satisfactory. This remission will be for three years for a Year 10 recipient or two years for a Year 11 recipient.
- 7. Each applicant must submit:
  - a) A completed Application form
  - b) Student's most recent school report and NAPLAN results
  - c) Student Statement on Participation in Other Activities endorsed by the student's Head of School, Director of Studies, Dean, Year Coordinator or person in a similar position at their current school
  - d) Confidential Statement of Financial Affairs for both parents if relying on need as one of the criteria
- 8. The Headmistress may interview selected applicants and their parents.
- 9. The School has the right to reject any application and shall not be required to give any reason for such rejection.
- 10. The School has the right to alter, amend and vary these conditions from year to year for further Royle Scholarships.
- 11. Completed applications must be returned by Friday 28 June 2024.
- 12. No student may hold two Abbotsleigh scholarships concurrently.

Note - The applicant should retain a photocopy of these conditions.
