Shaun Tan: The Art of Story Discovering *The Lost Thing* – Book to film 14 July to 18 August 2016

The Grace Cossington Smith Gallery is delighted to present a visual exploration of the process of creating Shaun Tan's *The Lost Thing* story from picture book to animated film.



Shaun Tan <u>http://www.shauntan.net/</u> is a multi-award winning Australian author and illustrator. His many books include *The Arrival, The Red Tree, Tales from Outer Suburbia, The Bird King and Rules of Summer* and *The Singing Bones. The Lost Thing <u>http://www.thelostthing.com/</u> published in 2000, is a story about identity and belonging.* 

The exhibition includes works and inspiration for the picture book: early sketches and roughs, final original illustrations and a dummy book. It explores the ten year collaborative process with the film team at *Passion Pictures* to create the 15 minute long animated film of *The Lost Thing*. Shaun's personal notes and comments, character sketches, pencil storyboards, soft pastel stills and texture paintings reveal this process.

The exhibition will show the animated film and a short film documenting the complex stages of its process of digital development from early structural stages to the final digital masterpiece, incorporating alternate and experimental pieces of film and sound.





*The Lost Thing* animation, directed by Shaun Tan and Andrew Ruhemann and narrated by Tim Minchin, has won many film awards in Australia and around the world including the 2011 Academy Award, The Oscar, for short animation.
