## Everett Scholarship – for Year 10

The Everett Scholarship was first offered in 2000 following a gift from Mrs Shirley Fong (AOG Shirley Lee, 1951) to honour Miss G Gordon Everett, a great Headmistress whose care and assistance inspired Shirley Fong and the many other young women who came under her guidance. Between 2000 and 2017 the scholarships were offered to one or two girls each year. From 2017, following an agreement with Mrs Fong, one scholarship is offered annually for two terms' fees in Year 10. The funds for this scholarship are managed by the Abbotsleigh Foundation.

### Conditions

1. One scholarship is available annually to a Year 9 Abbotsleigh student moving from Year 9 to Year 10. The scholarship gives special recognition to a student's sound academic progress, contribution to Senior School activities and a positive influence within the Senior School.
2. The scholarship provides remission of tuition fees for the first two terms of Year 10. The scholarship is not means tested.
3. The applicant must be a current day or boarding student at Abbotsleigh in Year 9 progressing to Year 10.
4. The applicant should submit the completed Application Form together with a statement on her contribution to Senior School activities.
5. Applications are invited by advertisement on the Parent Portal and Abbotsleigh parent app.
6. The scholarship is awarded each year after consideration of all applications. The Headmistress and Deputy Headmistress will interview shortlisted applicants.
7. The School has absolute discretion to withhold the scholarship from any applicant without the requirement to provide reasons.
8. The School has the right to alter, amend and vary these conditions and to discontinue or suspend the awarding of further scholarships.
9. No student may hold two Abbotsleigh Scholarships concurrently.

3. Describe the range of activities in which you have been involved during Year 7 to Year 9 at Abbotsleigh (for example, leadership, clubs, sport, music/choir, Duke of Edinburgh Award, service, community).
